### **LIFTING OF COVID 19 RESTRICTIONS**

At a recent PCC meeting we discussed the current Covid situation and the lifting of remaining restrictions in church. We agreed that we need to continue to take a cautious approach so that everybody coming into church can feel it is a safe environment in which to worship. So for the time being mask wearing will be encouraged for church, and mandatory for singing, unless exempt, (apart from the choir who are socially distanced from the congregation at all times); hand sanitising will continue, the South transept will be available for those who want to sit socially distanced. The children's area will be reinstated, with parent's/carers being responsible for maintaining a Covid secure environment in that area.

### **TEA/COFFEE AFTER THE 9.30 AM SERVICE**

We have all missed being able to congregate together after the 9.30 service for a time of fellowship and catch up over a cuppa. We are hoping to resume refreshments after the 9.30 service from Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> November but will only be able to do this if we have enough volunteers to prepare teas and coffees.
