## Flowers in Church

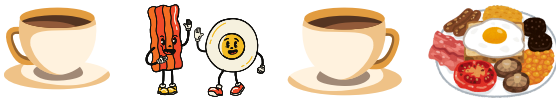
If you wish to sponsor a flower arrangement in church in the future to celebrate a special occasion or in memory of a loved one, this can be arranged & would be greatly appreciated.

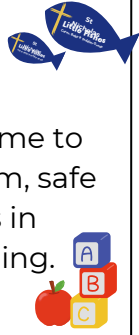
